Reserve Firefighter

The Position

The City of Napa is seeking qualified candidates for its Fire Reserve Program. The Napa Fire Reserve Program provides an excellent opportunity for individuals to gain valuable experience and training, as well as to participate in public service work. Training in the program is continuous, and includes all aspects of basic firefighting and basic emergency medical service. Reserve Firefighters are hired to assist with emergency responses; each Reserve is required to respond to a minimum of twenty calls per year. Additionally, Reserves are required to work two 12 hour shifts per month from 8am-8pm. The position of Reserve Firefighter provides training and experience, but does not guarantee a permanent position within the City of Napa. Reserve Firefighters are not part of the Civil Service system.

Salary:

This is an hourly position. Salary information will be available on the job announcement.

Minimum Qualifications

Demonstrated interest in community service and/or training or experience in firefighting preferred.

Ability to follow oral and written instructions; to learn modern fire suppression and prevention procedures and techniques; to use firefighting equipment safely and effectively; to treat and care for sick and injured individuals; to provide advanced first aid including CPR; to work effectively with others; to act quickly and calmly in emergency situations, and able to lift and carry heavy objects (50 lb. or more).

Reserve Firefighter candidates must be a minimum of 18 years of age. Incumbents must comply with the City residency requirement (30 minutes driving time, under normal driving conditions, from their place of residence to Fire Station One), and possess a valid California Driver's License.

Reserve Firefighter incumbents must be willing to work on an on-call basis, including holidays and weekends as required. A qualifying medical, background, and physical assessment will be required.

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Training Requirements:

- 18 (4-hour) training sessions a year.
- Required to train on Saturdays and weeknights.
 Specifics of time requirements will be included in the job announcement.
